From the subsequent appearance onwards, full weightage shall be assigned to the marks scored in the semester end examination and

the internal assessment marks secured during the course of study shall be ignored.
SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION Final Year students can apply for supplementary examination for a maximum of two courses thus providing an opportunity to complete their degree programme. Likewise students with less credits can also apply for supplementary examination for a maximum of two courses to enable them to earn minimum credits to move to higher semester. The students can apply for supplementary examination within three weeks of the declaration of results.
18.3 ONLINE / SELF STUDY COURSES Students are permitted to undergo department approved online/ self study courses not exceeding a total of six credits with the recommendation of the Head of the Department / Dean of School and with the prior approval of Dean Academic Affairs during his/ her period of study. In case of credits earned through online mode ratified by the respective Board of Studies, the credits may be transferred following the due approval procedures. The students shall undergo self study courses on their own with the mentoring of a member of the faculty. The online/ self study courses can be considered in lieu of elective courses.
