Decision Taken :

1. The Vice Chancellor emphasized the need for the Industry Institute meet and explained that such a meet will ensure close interaction between various industries and our University in terms consultancy, testing, training of Industrial personnel, internship for our students, staff and others.

After detailed discussion, it was decided to have the meeting on 22.10.2016. It was also decided that Dr. L. Aravind Kumaran, Assoc. Prof./MBA in consultation with Mr. S. Tajudeen, Director (Training, Placement, Industry-University Interaction and Alumni Coordination) will finalize the detailed programme and initiate measures for organizing the event.

2. It was also decided to hold the Parent Teachers meeting on 01.10.2016.
3. Vice Chancellor presented the observations made by the visiting NBA team during the exit meeting held on 21.08.2016. Vice Chancellor noted that for almost all the departments the deficiencies / weaknesses are in the areas of (i) quality research publications (ii) patents (iii) funded research projects and (iv) revenue through consultancy.
Vice Chancellor observed that department must initiate specific measures to overcome these deficiencies / weaknesses.
4. It is also decided that the publications of our faculty members and research scholars must only be in indexed and non-paid journals. Registrar observed that even if numbers of publications are less in the immediate future emphasis must be on quality publications. The numbers can be increased subsequently.
5. Dr. R. Raja Prabu, Dean (Academic Research) & NBA Coordinator reiterated that the University as a whole has embarked on outcome based teaching learning from the year 2013. Hence it is necessary to evaluate the attainment of the course outcomes for all the courses offered irrespective whether we are going for NBA Accreditation or not. After discussion it was decided that attainment of course outcomes are to be computed for all courses of this University.
6. It is also decided that all departments of this University particularly those offering programmes to the students, must conduct the board of studies meeting every semester. The attainment of the course outcome shall be one of the agenda items of the BOS meeting.



7. Registrar emphasized that the department Heads must conduct periodic department level faculty meetings and communicate the minutes of the same to Office of the Registrar.
8. Registrar informed the meeting of HODs and Deans that new posts of Deputy Dean (Academic Research), Deputy Dean (Academic Affairs) and Assistant Dean (Academic Affairs) are created to achieve the effective functioning of the Offices of the Dean (Academic Research) and Dean (Academic Affairs). He also informed the meeting that the following Professors are appointed for this post.
 - Deputy Dean (Academic Research) - Dr. J. Revathy, Prof./Civil
 - Deputy Dean (Academic Affairs) - Dr. M. Mohamed Ismail, Prof. /ECE
 - Assistant Dean (Academic Affairs) - Dr. R. Sathish Kumar, Assoc. Prof./Mech
9. Vice Chancellor informed that the faculty advisor system of one faculty member mentoring about 20 students is to be implemented in all departments in the current semester. This alone will ensure proper grooming of our students.
10. Vice Chancellor also called upon HODs and Deans to take up project based learning and lab restructuring very seriously and ensure their proper implementation. He also asked HODs to implement the peer assisted learning for all slow learners immediately after the first cycle test. These measures and making students to do mini projects and additional lab exercises will also enable students spending their free slots productively.
11. Registrar informed the meeting that Mr. S. Mohamed Tajudeen, Director, Placement and Training is re-designated as Director - Training, Placement, Industry-University Interaction and Alumni Coordination with effect from 01.09.2016. His duties and responsibilities include developing soft skill of students, enhancing placement, interaction with industry and alumni.
