Brief Report

Prof. T. Harinarayan, Director – ESPAC, B.S.A.R. Crescent Institute of Science and Technology has given a lecture to the faculty members all the departments on the topic of how to write quality research articles, project proposal and patents.

The following are the lecture points and guidelines provided to the faculties and research scholars:

- A project proposal should be unique to each project. The format for the proposal slightly varies as per the funding agency guidelines.
- The researcher should need to understand the mind of the people who will benefit from the project output. They will have many questions, and one need to make sure all those are answered in the project proposal document.
- Through step by step, the answers are provided for various questions to the faculties and researchers. Such as, problem finding, project/research strategic goal, benefit of the users (or) focus group, metrics and measures, deliverables, required resources, cost/budget, risk and issues, roles and responsibility of the coordinator/researcher, preparation of project report etc.,
- On writing of quality research articles/proposals, the following items like, executive summary, earlier work (national/international) of the researchers, requirements, solution, authorization, and appendix are the essential requirements.

Finally, he suggested and motivated the participants to write more research articles and publish in the reputed journals, and to plan with efforts to approach government sponsored project proposals agencies and file the patents.
