

Award of Seed money to the Faculty/research students 2020-21

Brief Report

Applications are invited from the faculty and research supervisors in the prescribed proforma for the year 2020-21 in order to award seed money to do small experiments for research. Based on the experiments, it is anticipated that faculty will publish research papers, file patents and also apply for funding from various Govt./ Non-Govt. agencies.

Main Objectives of the Crescent Seed Money Scheme are:

- To encourage faculty members/students to get actively involved in the research activities
- To motivate the faculty members to apply for research grants to funding agencies.
- To support research scholars and UG/PG final year students to complete their project work successfully with publications.
- To enhance the number of publications in the Science indexed journals.
- To file their findings in the form of Patents.

A total of 30 proposals from faculty are received and they made presentations before a committee on the research problems to be solved and the need for the Seed Money based on their innovative ideas. After scrutiny, the committee has recommended to sanction 27 projects. The total cost of the Crescent Seed Money for the projects is worth Rs 8,80,900/- . Faculty/Research students and also final year students have received the sanctioned letter, which was handed over to the awardees by Dr. A.Peer Mohamed, Vice Chancellor and Dr A. Azad, the Registrar, Dr Raja Hussain, Deputy Registrar.
