The Vice Chancellor and Registrar welcomed the members.

The following agenda items were discussed and decisions taken.

- Discussion in connection to the admission probability for the programmes B.Tech. Mechanical (Automobile) and B.Tech. Mechanical (Production) were discussed.


After detailed discussion with Director (Admissions) and other members it was decided to continue the old nomenclature for the UG programme as B.Tech Mechanical Engineering, B.Tech Automobile Engineering, B.Tech Production Engineering and B.Tech Manufacturing Engineering.

- Curriculum frame work for the proposed flexible PG programme was discussed. In order to have flexibility of teaching learning process it was decided to follow slotted timetable for both UG and PG programmes from the academic year 2016-17 onwards.  
In order to give flexible time slots for the needy students it was decided to reframe and rationalized the curriculum and syllabi of all PG programmes.
- In order to facilitate to undergo internship or to do project during eighth semester it was decided to permit the students who have completed sixth semester can do the courses belonging to eighth semester during the forth coming summer term from 15.6.2016 to 23.7.2016.

- The academic activities to be carried out for the proposed M.Arch and M.Sc.(Sonology) was discussed.

It was decided that the regulations, curriculum and syllabi of M.Arch should be framed by the Dean Crescent School of Architecture and the same may be sent to Dean (Academic Affairs) for getting approval from Chairman Academic council.

It was decided that the regulations, curriculum and syllabi of M.Sc. (Sonology) should be framed by the Dean (School of Life Sciences) and the same may be sent to Dean (Academic Affairs) for getting approval from Chairman Academic council.










