In order to have flexibility of teaching learning process it was decided to follow slotted timetable for both UG and PG programmes from the academic year 2016-17 onwards. In order to give flexible time slots for the needy students it was decided to reframe and rationalized the curriculum and syllabi of all PG programmes.</p>	<p>Noted. Engineering departments / Schools initiated efforts and framed the draft Curriculum and Syllabi of PG programmes offered by them under Regulation 2016 by taking care of rationalization to facilitate more academic flexibility to students.</p>
4	<p>In order to facilitate to undergo internship or to do project during eighth semester it was decided to permit the students who have completed sixth semester can do the courses belonging to eighth semester during the forthcoming summer term from 15.6.2016 to 23.7.2016.</p>	<p>Noted. HoDs / School Deans were asked to disseminate the information to the potential students and accordingly plan for conducting summer pre-do courses during June-July 2016 based on need.</p>
