Report on the release of Seed Money Project

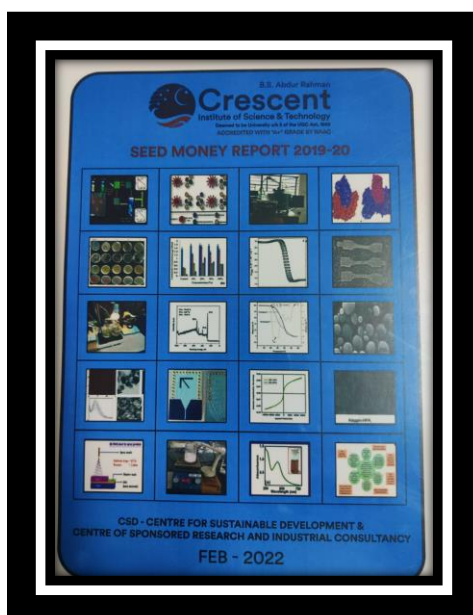
