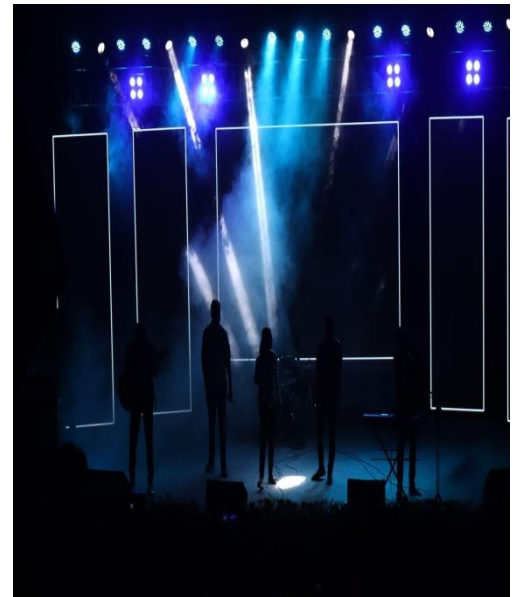

1.5 -CRESCENT CLUB OF PHOTOGRAPHERS

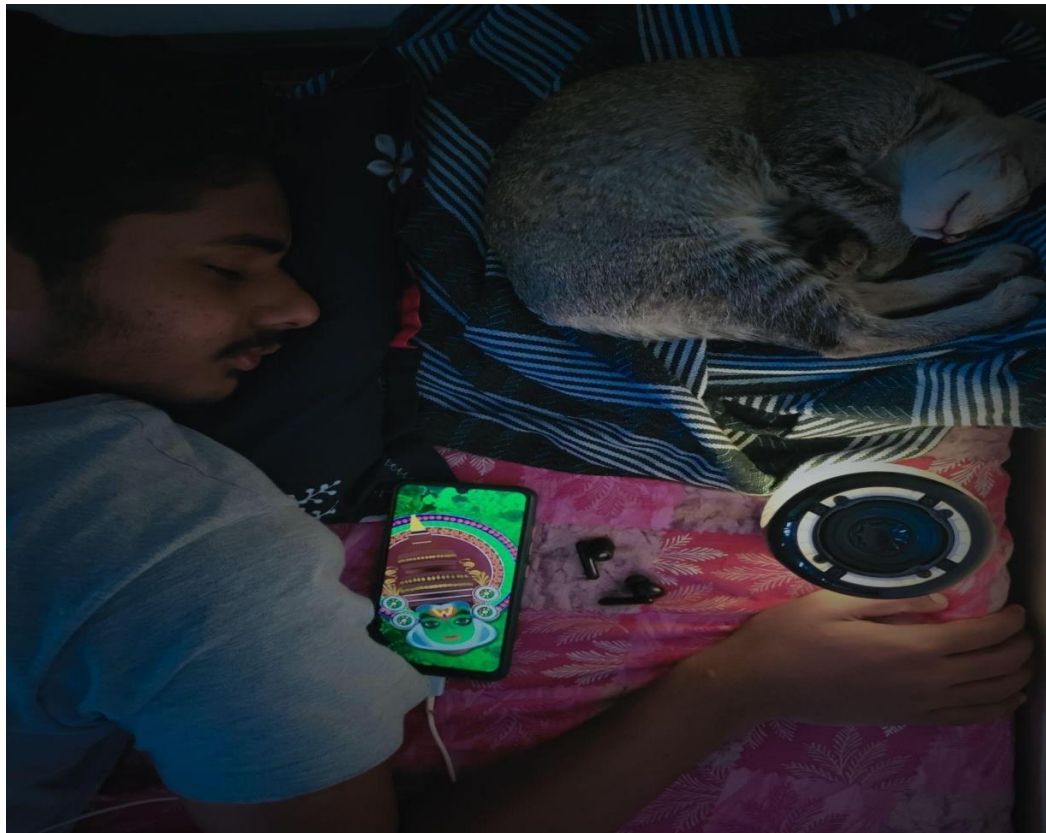

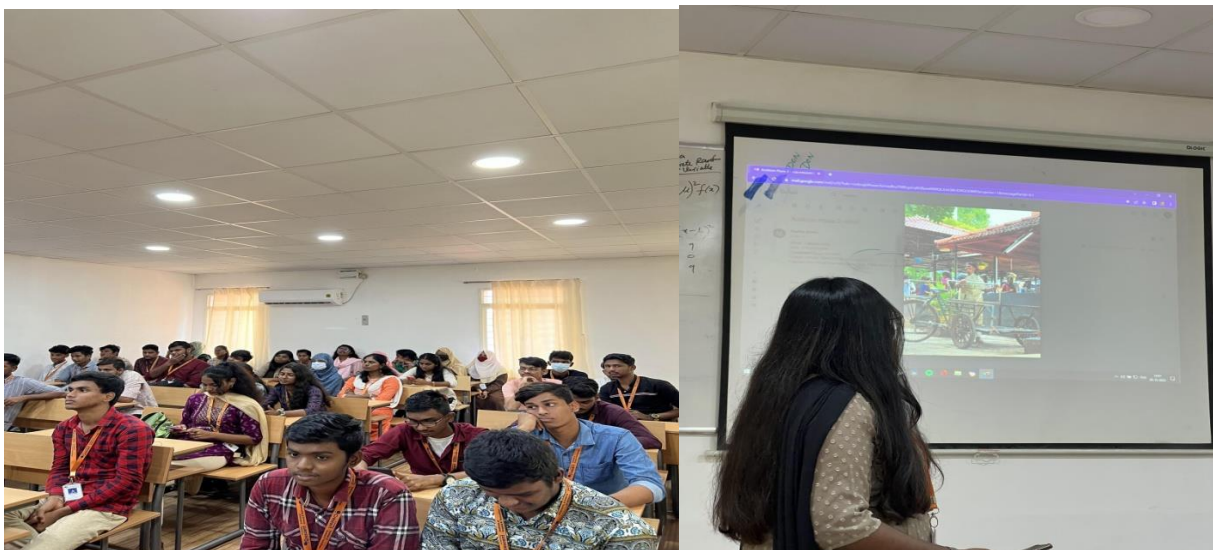

1.8 - CRESCENT LITERARY SOCIETY

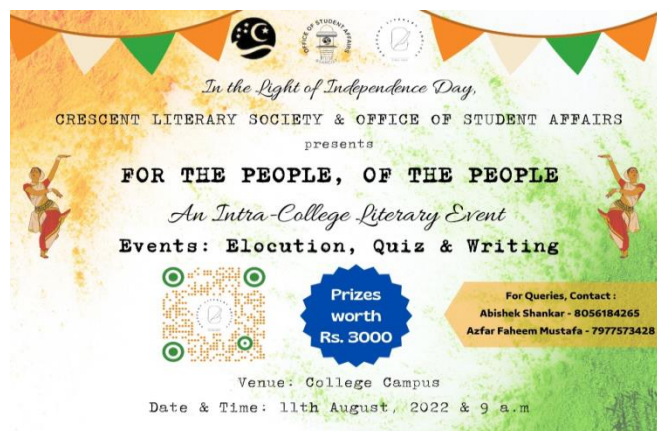

QUIZ:


2.CRESCENT STUDENT COUNCIL

- **Entrepreneurship in the Lean Startup**

From early development to language acquisition to product and service purchases, to the decision to check email on one's phone amidst a crowd, his human proclivity for imitative conduct has been noticed and researched several times. Humans are greatly impacted by what they see (physically or virtually) others doing in all of these scenarios. Entrepreneurship has the potential to spread virally, but it must be introduced early and frequently in contexts where it is not.

- **Social Skills**

You become more charming through honing your social abilities, which is a desired attribute. People are drawn to charismatic individuals because charismatic individuals are (or appear to be) more interested in them. Most individuals understand that solid interpersonal relationships are essential for success in life. Social skills that have been fine-tuned may improve your happiness and contentment, as well as your attitude on life.

- **Women Empowerment**

Women are currently living better lives than ever before. If the marriage does not work out, they will not make any compromises. They are increasingly self-sufficient, and their health is improving in comparison to previous decades. Women are entering the labor force in greater numbers. They are demonstrating their abilities in non-traditional domains such as law enforcement, defense, administration, journalism, and research.

- **Innovation and Technology**

Without quick development in these areas – progress that is comparable with the rapid technical advance – an increasing number of individuals and entire civilizations will be left

behind. This would be in sharp contrast to the SDG aspirations that governments have set for themselves. Science and technology are advancing at a rapid pace. In fact, the epidemic has expedited it, revealing new ideas and modes of collaboration. These will continue to have far-reaching consequences for the economy, society and environment. We must guarantee that they benefit everyone while also furthering the SDGs. Rapid technical advancements are almost never neutral. They can pose remarkable policy and socioeconomic issues, involving a diverse set of stake holders.

- **Healthcare and Medical**

Many coverage policies change how much families have to pay for health care, generally by changing what government programs pay on their behalf or by changing how health care's pending burdens are shared between people with larger and smaller health care needs. But other proposals aim to reduce the underlying cost of healthcare, either by reducing how many healthcare services patients receive or by reducing the prices paid for those services. Policies like these have the potential to reduce overall healthcare's pending throughout the system, but this is often easier said than done.

- **Digital Revolution**

Many coverage policies alter how much families need to pay for healthcare, either by changing what government programs pay on their behalf or by altering how healthcare spending responsibilities are distributed among persons with varying health care requirements. Other suggestions, on the other hand, seek to decrease the underlying cost of health care, either by reducing the number of medical services that people get or by reducing the rates paid for those services. These policies have the potential to reduce overall health-care spending from across the system, but it is often times easier said than done.

Apart from the themes mentioned above, the speakers spoke about their personal experience throughout their lifetime and many more to come in the future. It was truly an inspiring presentation of array of themes which made the audience truly motivated.
