### Report on the Intra- Department Event

As part of Crescent Literarian Hub's literary activities, the second-year students of B.A. English organised the Intra-Department event "LIT TRIVIA" on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2024 (Tuesday) for their seniors and juniors. Dr. P. Rathna, Professor and Head, convened the event and Mr. T. Sugadev, Assistant Professor & CLH Faculty Coordinator coordinated the event.

Chakravarthi, Aren Runa, Subha Shree, and Nakshathra served as student coordinators for the event. The event commenced with a Quirath recited by Iffath Alia, a 2nd-year B.A. English student. Dr. P. Rathna, the Convenor of the event, addressed the students and encouraged them to actively participate in intercollegiate events. She also advised students to positively make use of the library resources as well as human resources in the department to enhance their knowledge and engage proactively in the academic activities.

Following this, II Year B.A. English Student Swarna Rekha and her team, Subha Shree, Anshiya, and Dhanya, presented a scene from William Shakespeare's *Twelfth Night*.

The Second-year students conducted three events as part of 'Lit Trivia'.
