Virtual Student Exchange Program

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Universitas Islam Bandung (UNISBA), Indonesia and BS Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai (Deemed to be University) on 31st January 2024 to facilitate faculty and student exchange programs, joint research projects, and curriculum development initiatives in areas of mutual interest, including sustainable development and circular economy. As a part of MoU, first virtual student exchange program was started in the month of February 2024, for which 39 students in the Department of Commerce was enrolled for the following courses,



Virtual Student Exchange Program was designed to foster cross-cultural collaboration, enhance academic skills, and provide students with a global perspective on key academic topics. Conducted online sessions, offering them the opportunity to engage in collaborative learning and develop soft skills in communication, teamwork, and problem-solving.

Program Overview The program was conducted over 6 months, featuring a combination of live lectures, interactive sessions, case studies, and group projects. Our students actively participated in the session and gained diverse range of perspectives and learning experiences. The virtual program was divided into three main courses,

- 1. Financial Management and Investment Analysis focusing on financial statements, budgeting, cash flow management, and capital structure and Covering topics such as equity analysis, bond markets, risk assessment, and portfolio optimization.
- 2. Creative thinking and analytical data program focussed on encouraging participants to think outside the box, challenge conventional wisdom, and approach problems with innovative solutions.
- **3. Global social entrepreneurship** virtual session was featured expert-led seminars, peer collaboration, and group-based problem-solving. Understanding the fundamental concepts of social entrepreneurship, including the triple bottom line of people, planet, and profit.





Key Activities of the program


- Lectures and Webinars: Expert faculty and industry professionals delivered lectures on their selected courses.
- Thematic Learning Sessions: Each week, students engaged in lectures, discussions, and workshops on topics such as financial management, investment analysis, Global social entrepreneurship, Creative thinking and analytical data.
- **Group Projects**: Teams of students from different countries were tasked with solving real-world problems or developing innovative solutions. These projects emphasized teamwork, critical thinking, and cultural awareness.
- **Virtual Cultural Exchange**: Students shared aspects of their own culture, including language, traditions, and values, through virtual presentations, videos, and discussion forums.
- **Industry Interaction**: Guest speakers from global industries provided insights into international career opportunities, industry trends, and professional skills development.

Outcomes of the program

- Enhanced Global Awareness: Students gained a deeper understanding of global issues and the role of their field in addressing them.
- **Skill Development**: Students improved their communication, leadership, and problem-solving skills through collaboration with international peers.
- **Cultural Appreciation**: The program fostered respect and appreciation for cultural diversity, enabling students to develop a more inclusive mindset.



• **Networking**: Students formed lasting connections with peers and mentors from around the world, creating a foundation for future collaboration.



The Virtual Student Exchange Program was a valuable experience for students, providing them with both academic and personal growth. The international collaboration enriched their understanding of global issues and improved their capacity for cultural sensitivity and professional competence. Future iterations of the program could include extended time for cultural immersion activities and enhanced technological support to overcome technical barriers.
