Ms. Kaaviya Balakrishnan, our alumna from the 2017-2021 was the Resource Person. Finished her Master's in Medical Forensics last year at Uppsala University in Sweden, where she studied on a full scholarship. During her Master's, she also had the chance to work as a summer researcher at the Max Planck Institute in Germany, and she did an Erasmus traineeship at the University of Vienna in Austria, both with scholarships. After that, she worked full-time in a paid, elected position with the student union at Uppsala University. This October, she I'll be starting her PhD at the University of Warsaw in Poland, supported by two different scholarships. Although her main field is biotechnology, she has picked up a lot of experience in administration and securing funding through extracurricular.

She has studied and worked in several European countries and has secured multiple scholarships over the past few years.

Nearly 30 students from the various departments, participated in the event, and they also clarified their doubts regarding international internships. She shared whatever she has learned with students interested in studying abroad in Europe and applying for scholarships.
