The title of famous works of literature is to be acted out without any words and the team members must identify the correct literary work.

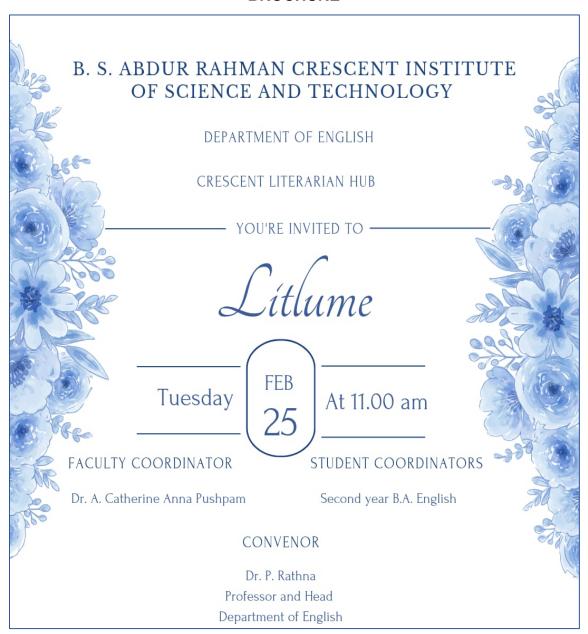
### Event 3 – 2 Truths 1 Lie
