The National Service Scheme (NSS) and UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN (UBA) of B. S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology, in collaboration with the Environmentalist Foundationof India (EFI), successfully organized a "Mega Beach Cleaning Drive" on the 2nd of October, 2024. 
