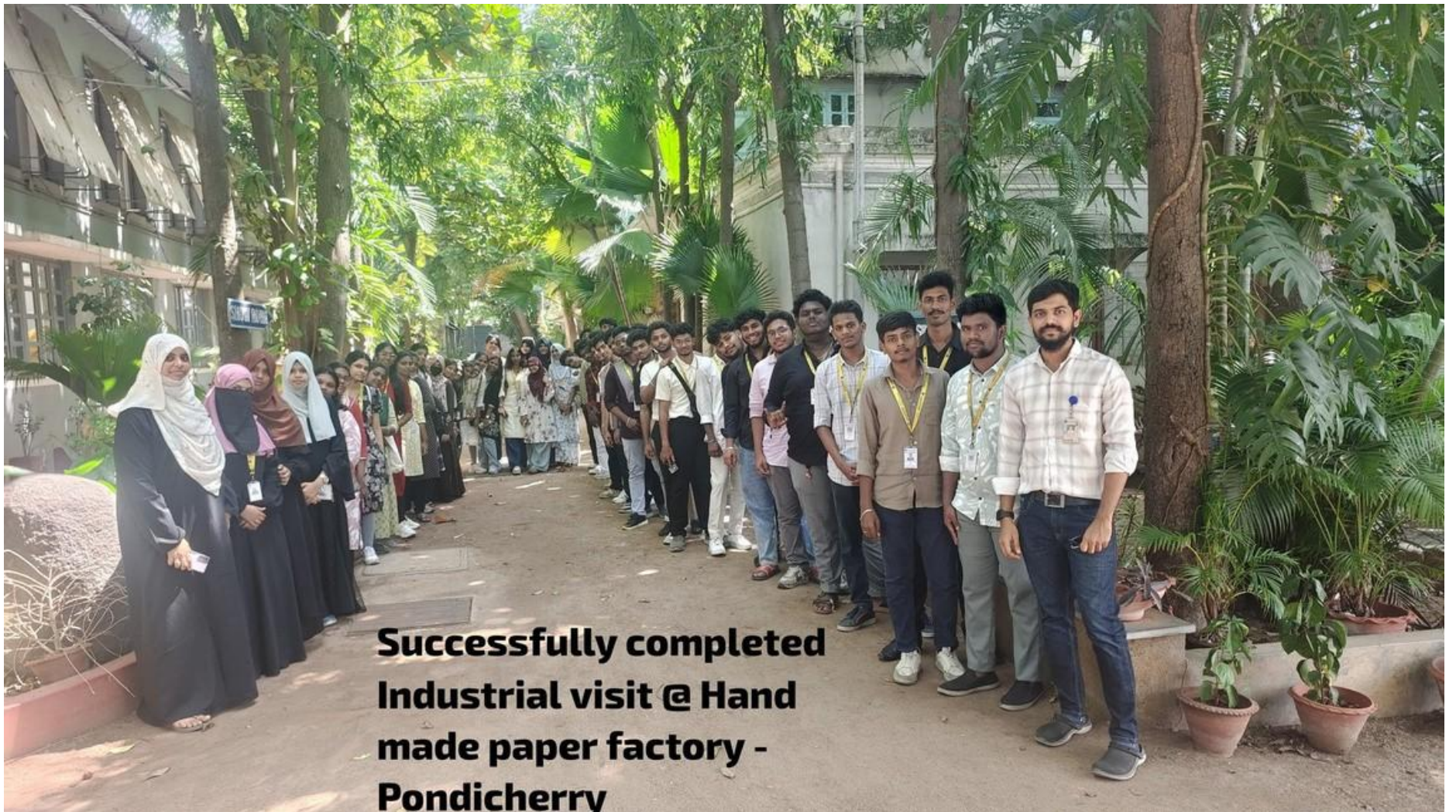

As part of our academic curriculum, we had the opportunity to visit a paper manufacturing industry in Pondicherry. The purpose of this visit was to gain practical exposure to the operations of the paper industry and to understand the production processes, raw materials, machinery, and environmental measures adopted by the company.

To understand the manufacturing process of paper, raw material and their conversion into finished product, the machines and technology used in production, to gain knowledge of quality control and waste management practices.

The paper industry we visited is one of the leading paper manufacturers in Pondicherry, engaged in producing writing paper, printing paper, packaging boards, and specialty papers. The company follows eco-friendly practices and uses both wood-based and recycled raw materials.

Raw Material preparation-Collection of wood pulp and Baniya clothing and waste paper

pulping process-Conversion of raw materials into pulp using Mechanical and non chemical methods.



The above pictures show beautifully designed handmade sheets crafted from cotton paper. These sheets come in various patterns and colors, and they are mainly used as wallpapers, decorative wrapping papers, and for other creative purposes. Along with sheets, paper bags are also made from cotton paper, with their handles and strips created from leftover scraps, ensuring nothing goes to waste.

All of these products are handcrafted, giving them a unique and artistic touch. An important highlight is that even waste paper scraps are recycled and reused to make eco-friendly handmade pencils. This process not only promotes sustainability but also reduces waste by turning scraps into useful and attractive products.

Overall, these items reflect eco-friendly craftsmanship, combining creativity with recycling to produce decorative sheets, paper bags, and pencils that are both functional and sustainable.
