**Report on Sustainability Pledge Program**

As part of the *Bharat Sustainability Mission 2026* and in observance of Earth Week (April 22–29, 2026), the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of B.S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology organized a Sustainability Pledge Program on 29th April 2026 at the university campus. The initiative aimed to promote environmental consciousness and responsible behavior among students.

Objectives of the event was to to create awareness about environmental sustainability, encourage eco-friendly habits among students , promote responsible use of natural resources, reduce plastic usage and waste generation and motivate students to actively participate in sustainability initiatives

The program witnessed active participation of around 2000 students from various departments. Faculty members also contributed significantly by organizing and guiding students throughout the activity.

Faculty members conducted awareness sessions within classrooms, highlighting:

- The importance of sustainability in daily life
- Conservation of water and energy resources
- The harmful effects of plastic pollution
- The need for biodiversity protection
- The role of youth in achieving sustainable development goals

These sessions helped students understand the urgency of environmental issues and the importance of adopting sustainable practices.
